The Zuytdorp restaurant is named after a famous Dutch ship which ran aground about 65 kms North of Kalbarri in 1712 on its way to the Dutch East Indies. This part of the building has been designed with a mariners décor theme through out and was mostly used for the a la carte menu or special seafood buffets, for coaches and special functions eg wedding. The Zuytdorp comfortably seats 100 diners.



Jakes Bistro, was run as a daily smorgasbord/salad bar, very popular with the locals and tourists alike. Jakes seats approximately 100 guests. This side of the building boasts a separate games room with a pool table, full sound system, DJ box, stage, wide screen projector and bar.

Both restaurants were licensed with each having a fully equipped bar and worked out of the same huge, recently renovated kitchen with separate entrances, toilets, cool rooms and air conditioning.



The successful purchaser will also acquire virtually every bit of equipment required just to walk in, add your personal touch and get the place rocking again!

Potential Resort Connections

The Zuytdorp Restaurant and Jakes Bistro are part of the Kalbarri Beach Resort complex and in the past were advertised with the Resort to include the licensed restaurant as a facility. Resort packages also used to include accommodation and meals so having this captive audience would again be a tremendous benefit.

Trading Hours

In the past the Zuytdorp opened from 6 a.m. until 8.30 a.m. for breakfast, provided there were coaches booked into the resort or during School Holidays when the resort is generally full. Dinner was provided in both the Zuytdorp and Jakes from 5.30 p.m. until late, 7 days per week. Outside catering, conventions and weddings were catered for as required.

Liquor Licenses

The previous business carried on at the premises had a liquor licence and it is the sole responsibility of the purchaser to apply for a transfer of the existing licence and/or apply for a new licence as required, and that the mortgagee makes no representations in respect of the liquor licence, and that this is a matter solely the responsibility of the purchaser.

Equipment

It is a condition of the sale of this property that the successful purchaser also enter into a contract to buy the equipment that is situated on the premises. A list of the equipment is available upon request. The market value of the equipment has been determined as \$132,461.30, and the price will be inclusive of the price payable for the equipment. What this means is that the price will be for both the land and the equipment, with the final price being allocated \$132,461.30 to the equipment, and the balance of the purchase price to the land

- > There is not an upmarket Seafood specialist restaurant in Kalbarri.



Kalbarri is on the West Australian coastline, 590 kilometres North of Perth and 159 kilometres North of Geraldton. It is part of the "Australian Coral Coast" region, which includes other well known destinations such as Monkey Mia, Shark Bay and the Ningaloo Reef.
